- Change your password

To find: Colleges I'm Thinking About / Compare me

- Click on the "colleges" tab at the top
- Click on the "colleges I'm thinking about" link at the top
- Add a few colleges
- Click "compare me"
 - The averages shown are for students from ESD that have been accepted to that particular college. School averages are displayed in green when your number is higher and in red when your number is lower. Your PSAT score, if available, has been converted to the equivalent SAT score and compared to the average single SAT score of an accepted student. The column labeled "Accept" shows the number of students accepted out of the number of students that applied.

To find: General College Info / Overlaps

- Click on the "colleges" tab at the top
- Click on the "colleges I'm thinking about" link at the top
- Click on one of the colleges in your list
 - View general information about the college
 - View Application History
 - Click "overlaps" to get an idea of other colleges that ESD students who applied to this college also applied to. (This is helpful if you're trying to expand your list and aren't sure where to start.)

To find: Scattergrams

- Click on the "colleges" tab at the top
- Click on "scattergrams" from the list on the right side of the screen
 - Choose a college you're interested in attending
 - Choose a standardized test you've taken (most of you should have a PSAT score, so choose SAT if that's the only test you've taken so far).
 - Click "display graph" to see where your grades and test scores fall compared to ESD students who have applied in the last four years.

To find: Information for College Visits

- Click on the "colleges" tab at the top
- Click the "view all upcoming college visits" link on the right side of the screen
 - This is a list of colleges that will be on ESD's campus in the fall to visit with our students during the school day. Please click the "sign up" link if you see a college that you are interested in! You will need to get permission from your teacher to miss class for this meeting.
