- Upper School exams will be given in the following locations
 - o Regular, 2-hour exams in the Competition Gym
 - o Extended time students in the Auxiliary Gym, and a second location TBD
 - Students requiring computer use during exams will be in the back section of each room, there will not be separate computer rooms.
- If you come in late, you have lost that time. You WILL NOT be allowed to stay late to finish
- The usual rule of no one leaving before 1.5 hours will still be in effect.
- Once you leave the room, please exit the building completely so we can maintain a quiet environment for the other students still testing.
- Only one student allowed in the bathroom at a time.
- Conflict exams (for example, a student with two science exams) should be arranged by the student with the teachers involved. There is no official form to be filled out, it is simply an arrangement between the teacher and student.
- We do not allow students to move exams to a different time slot for "convenience".
- Dress appropriately for exams. Casual is ok, but not too casual. Slippers and/or pajamas are not acceptable.
- We do not allow hats to be worn while taking exams. Don't bring one.
- DO NOT HAVE A CELL PHONE OUT WHILE YOU ARE IN THE EXAM ROOM. Leave your phone locked up in your car, or in your locker. Once you walk in the doors of that exam room, there should NEVER be a cell phone out. Period. If you are found in possession of a cell phone (in your pocket, at your table, on the floor near your table, etc.) we will remove the phone and take 10 points off of your exam. If you are seen using your phone at any time, that will be an automatic Academic Pledge violation.
- Do not bring books, notes, or any study material into the exam room.
- Be on time.
- Do not bring food or drink into the exam room. Water bottles are ok.
- Make up exams are in room A. This is also where you would take an exam missed due to illness.
- Exams are "open campus," meaning that you are only required to be on campus when you are taking an exam. You are allowed to leave once your exam is over. You may eat lunch off campus, or there is a lunch available on the first three days of exams in the Dining Commons. Please remember that you may only eat fast food on campus in the outside areas, not in any of the buildings.
- Lunch on campus begins at 11:30 am, and please be aware that the Middle School will be on a regular schedule, so we will need to be courteous and let them have their usual tables.
- If you choose to stay on campus while not taking an exam, please study quietly. Remember that the Middle School still has classes in session.
